Student Checklist

STUFF TO BRING

- · A fantastic attitude and a desire to draw near to God
- Bible, pen, notebook, etc.
- Casual clothing for three days (Shorts that are at least finger tip length and pants are acceptable for all meetings, including worship).
- · Beach towel for water day
- · Closed toe shoes for recreation and missions
- · Towels and washcloths
- Sheets, blanket, pillow, sleeping bag, etc. (unless otherwise told)
- · Personal hygiene items
- Spending money for snacks, t-shirts, CDs, etc.
- Watch
- Alarm clock
- Sunscreen

STUFF NOT TO BRING

- We prefer to keep a distraction-free environment. Please check with your group leader for guidelines related to what you can and cannot bring.
- Spaghetti strap tops, halter tops, and tube tops. Tank tops that are atleast three fingers wide can be worn during the day, but not to evening worship.
- Tight clothing
- "Short" shorts or skirts (Stand with your arms by your side. If your fingertips are touching skin, your shorts or skirt should be longer for camp.)
- Bikinis or two piece bathing suits (Unless covered with a dark t-shirt)
- Speedos
