

Pack List for Beach Camp

- Fantastic Attitude
- Bible and a Pen (if you don't have a paper bible, let Peter know we'll have some) –no phones to be used in small group or large group times.
- Casual clothing for our time there
- Beach towel for ...the beach and around pool
- Towel for showering
- Bedding: twin size bunks are provided. So pillow, flat sheet & blanket or sleeping bags work great, it get's kind of cool at night in the dorm rooms
- Personal hygiene items (toothbrush, deodorant, soaps, etc)
- Medicines you might need (these can be turned in at check in for distribution when necessary) -we have two RN's going this year
- Spending \$ for snacks or souvenirs (but not mandatory)
- \$ for travel meals (unless otherwise arranged with leaders)
- Swim Suit (no bikini's – guys or girls, a tank top can be worn over)
- Sunscreen (we will have some on hand, but you might want your own)
- A refillable water bottle (suggested)

What NOT to Bring

- We prefer a distraction-free environment. So modest in dress is appreciated.
- No Spaghetti strap tops, halter-tops and tube tops. Tank tops that are at least three fingers wide are good during the day, but not to the main group sessions.
- Pets, alligators, unicorns, or toucans
- Tight clothing
- "Short" shorts or skirts. (stand with your arms by your side, if your fingertips are touching skin, your shorts & skirts should be longer for camp)
- Bikini's – unless covered with a dark colored shirt
- Speedos (like the kind worn at swimming competition)
- Tobacco, drugs, vapes, alcohol or weapons
- Irreplaceable items
- Fireworks
- Water balloons
- Clothing with 'questionable saying, slogans, etc.
- Clothing that promotes alcohol, cigarettes or such
- Skateboards, roller skates or blades

Cell Phone, iPad & personal electronic device Policy: You may bring your phone.

-During travel we will have designated 'no phone times' use this time to actually talk to someone.

-Phones will not be permitted at times of worship or during small group times.

-During our drive, it's requested that movies over PG-13 rating or music with explicit lyrics not be viewed or listened to (breaking of this rule may result in your phone getting locked up for the week).

-You will not be allowed to isolate yourself in 'phone world' (Once at camp: there will be no Netflix, Hulu, Youtube or such)

-You must comply with leaders when requested to put phones away

-Don't ask an adult or another student to guard, protect or carry your phone (it's best off just to leave it in your room.)

-At night phones will be placed in a 'phone basket' in a location in each dorm room (no sleeping with your phone in your bed)

-All phones should have a security code (if your parent does not know your password, you will be asked to write it down, place in an envelope, seal it, and sign the back...these will be securely stored and only opened in emergency...envelope will be returned or destroyed at end of trip).

-Stay away from texting and social media drama...this stuff can harm your awesome camp experience.

*If for any reason, your device becomes a distraction, you will be asked to turn it off and store it...if necessary the device will be taken and stored until the end of camp.
